By way of the instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to release the leave encashment and the gratuity amount.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case the authorities are directed to decide the case of the petitioner within a stipulated period.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a retired employee, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present

petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents, to finalize the proceedings pending against the petitioner within a period of five months from today and to pass a reasoned order after affording opportunity/hearing to the petitioner.
