The petitioners have made two prayers in this writ petition. Firstly, he has prayed for mandamus, directing the official respondents to remove respondent No.6 from the post of Sarpanch and secondly, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 04.11.2015.

Insofar as the first prayer is concerned, no mandamus can be issued as the procedure is prescribed under the Punjab Panchayati Raj Act,1994 (for short,'the Act') and insofar as the order dated 04.11.2015 is concerned, argument of learned counsel for the petitioners is that the said order has been passed without issuing any notice.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and examining

the available record, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioners have a remedy of filing an application before respondent No.3 for vacation of stay. But so far as the preset petition is concerned, it is not maintainable.
