Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to extend the time period of the Managing Committee of Sartaj Cooperative House Building Society Ltd., as well as, its President.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner submits that term of the Managing Committee, as well as, of the President of Sartaj Cooperative House Building Society Ltd. has already expired on 21.11.2015. He further submits that petitioner has already submitted a

of term of President, as well as, Managing Committee of the Society, but no decision has been taken thereupon so far.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to respondents Nos. 2 and 3 – Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab and Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Roopnagar, respectively, to look into the grievance of the petitioner, specifically, made in representation dated 21.10.2015 (Annexure P/6) and take appropriate action in accordance with law.
