MAHESH GROVER, J.

The petitioner questions the educational qualification acquired by respondent no.4 without seeking permission from the competent authority. He thus contends that this is a serious matter which should be interfered into and respondent no.4 be visited with consequences on account of the lapse.

It has been conceded by the petitioner that respondent no.4 is his brother and he is having a feud with him over property matters and inheritance.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the considered view that the petition is totally frivolous as the petitioner wants to use the agency of the Court to settle his scores. Hence, instant petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.50,000/- which shall be deposited before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
