After going through the order dated 20.02.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Government on the direction issued by this court on a writ petition (CWP No. 1262 of 2014) filed by the petitioner, we find that various steps have been taken to improve the TFR (Total Fertility Rate). For that purpose, the policies have been evolved and expanded to educate and motivate people and make available different methods of contraception. Sterilisation Camps are being organised. The usage of Intrauterine Contraceptives Devices has improved over the years. Sufficient stock of contraceptives are supplied from the State Headquarter and resultantly, the TFR (Total Fertility Rate) has been reduced, and there is definite improvement in the unmet need of contraceptives in the State of Haryana.

In view of the above, we do not find any reason to issue further direction at this stage, as the Government has already taken the requisite steps.
