Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release electricity connection to the petitioner without any further delay.

The petitioner has been allotted a Flat bearing No.293, 4th Floor, in the United Cooperative House Building Society Ltd., Sector 68, Mohali, vide allotment letter issued in the year 2004 (Annexure P/2). The petitioner is a member of the Society as per certificate of membership (Annexure P/1). The allotment with respect to the aforesaid Flat is covered by the judgments of this Court passed on 31.08.2012 in

C.W.P. No. 16387 of 2012 titled “Simran Chahal versus Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. (Annexure P/3) and 07.11.2012 in C.W.P. No. 21061 of 2012 titled “Amandeep Kaur vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd.” (Annexures P/4). The petitioner is not a party in any writ petition nor in any contempt petition, which is pending in this Court.

In view of the judgments of this Court dated 31.08.2012 (Annexure P/3) and 07.11.2012 (Annexure P/4), the present writ petition is disposed of, without issuing notice to the respondents, with a direction to the concerned respondent to pass an appropriate order on legal notice dated 15.10.2015 (Annexure P/9) in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
