LISA GILL, J.

It is contended that the petitioners, who are Telephone Operators/Attendants, are entitled for revision of grade pay at par with Bill Distributors in terms of Circular dated 15.12.2011 issued by the Government of Punjab as well as Circular dated 24.05.2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that legal notice dated 22.09.2015 (Annexure P-6) has been served upon the respondents but to no avail. At this stage, it is prayed that respondent No. 3 be directed to decide said legal notice in a time bound manner and afford benefits due to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to

expeditiously decide legal notice dated 22.09.2015 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioners by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioners shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
