MAHESH GROVER.J.

The petitioner questions the promotion of respondents No.3 and 4 on the ground that they do not have a degree/diploma from an university recognized by the State of Haryana. Passing a diploma is one of the pre-requisite envisaged in the eligibility criteria for promotion to the post of Assistant Labour Commissioner.

The petitioner has made a complaint to the authorities who have taken note of it and thus made the impugned order of promotion of the two respondents subject to the outcome of the complaint. For this reason I would not deem it appropriate to entertain the instant writ petition at this stage but would leave the issue to the respondents who are looking into the aspect of

eligibility of the petitioner. The petition stands disposed of with an expectation from the respondents that they would expedite the decision on the complaint and take an appropriate action thereon, if found to be correct.
