The petitioners by way of present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India have sought writ of certiorari to quash the acquisition proceedings in pursuant to notification dated 24.3.1987 (Annexure P-2) issued under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (in short "the Act") and dated 28.7.1987 (Annexure P-3) under Section 6 of the Act. Further prayer for direction to the respondents to release their land has also been made.

2. In view of reply filed by the State, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a detailed and comprehensive representation before the concerned authority as they are in physical possession of the land in dispute.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
