Rajesh Bindal, J.

The petitioner, whose wife was working as Child Development Project Officer, died in a road accident on 5.12.2012, has filed the present petition with the grievance that from July, 2014 onwards, the financial benefits available in terms of the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pension) Part-II Rules, 2009, had not been paid and further that a sum of ₹ 1 lac was withheld out of terminal benefits due to the petitioner.

Reply filed on behalf of the respondents in Court is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that upto date financial benefits to which the petitioner is entitled to on account of death of his wife have been paid upto January, 2015. He further submitted that ₹ 1 lac have been detained as certain amount was due against the deceased employee on account of house building advance and the interest due thereon. It is not in dispute that the petitioner was never informed about the exact loan to be paid by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the details of the amount due from the deceased wife of the petitioner on account of house building advance loan may be informed to the petitioner and in case the due amount is less than ₹ 1 lac, the balance may be paid to him after deducting the same and if it is more than that, it may be informed to him and he will clear the account.

Learned counsel for the State submitted that the detailed information regarding the amount due from the petitioner on account of principal and the interest of the house building advance loan taken by his wife shall be furnished within 10 days, and thereafter the petitioner shall clear that account.

In view of the aforesaid undertakings, the present petition is disposed of.
