DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

The respondents-State of Punjab through the impugned order dated 24.9.2012 (Annexure P-2) had sought to recover a sum of Rs.1,50,320/- from the petitioner on account of withdrawal of special increments and pay scales which according to the respondent-State had wrongly been paid to the petitioner's late husband.

On notice having been issued, written statement has been filed on behalf of respondent No.4-Principal Accountant General, (A & E), Punjab wherein it has been stated that through letter dated 21.4.2015, it has been decided that the recovery of Rs.1,50,320/- effected from the petitioner should have not been made and the same be released to her.

The above letter dated 21.4.2015 renders the present petition infructuous. However, a direction is issued to the respondents to release the amount of Rs.1,50,320/- to the petitioner in terms of the above said letter dated 21.4.2015 within one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of accordingly.
