Prayer in the present petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the benefits of service to the petitioner in terms of the order passed in CWP No.759 of 2010.

In pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 23.12.2014, the Treasury Officer, Ambala, Ms. Sunita Punia, is present in the Court. She states that the entire amount in terms of CWP No.759 of 2010, stands paid to the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner admits the factum of payment. However, he submits that the petitioner retired on 30.09.2008. The retiral benefits were illegally withheld. Therefore, he

states that interest on the delayed payment be allowed to him.

In view of the fact that the entire retiral benefits have already been paid to the petitioner, no further orders are required to be passed.

However, the petitioner, if so advised to file a representation before the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No.2, claiming interest on the delayed payment of retiral dues, the same be decided in the light of the judgment rendered by this Court in *Maha Singh Sinhmar Vs. State of Haryana, 1994(3) PLR 409*, within four months from the date of receipt of such representation.
