Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in respect of the relief claimed in this petition, a legal notice is stated to have been served on behalf of the petitioner, upon the respondents, on 2.12.2014, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-3.

He further submits that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondents to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice within a specified period.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority amongst the respondents, to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice, by passing a speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case the relief sought in this petition, or any part thereof, is found due, the same shall be released to the petitioner, within a period of two months thereafter, along with statutory interest amount where payable, and interest amount @ 7% per

annum, on due amounts where no statutory interest is laid down.

However, if for any legally valid reasons, the relief sought by the petitioner, or any part thereof, is not found due, detailed reasons for the same shall be given in the speaking order to be passed.
