The prayer in writ petition has become stale for I cannot make an intervention in favour of only the petitioner for making admission for Session 2014-15 in the late weeks of the month of February. The consideration for admission became possible by virtue of the order passed by this Court in CWP No.23829 of 2014 delivered on 04.12.2014 allowing for the Government to extend time for admission and secured the cost of the advertisement through a public notification for admission before 12.12.2014. The counsel for the State on instructions from Kesho Ram, Accountant, Director Sectr., Haryana, Gurgaon submits that all the colleges participated and there were more seats still vacant than there were students willing to take admission. While the petitioner colleges 2 and 3 could make admission of certain students, the petitioner could not secure any admission of students, since there was no student who was prepared to take admission in that college. The State counsel states that even after the 8th counselling they

made 2 more sessions of counselling and if one more opportunity is given, the petitioner will fill up the seats. I cannot allow the admission to be open for the session 2014-15 at this time. The petitioner-Institute can obtain no more benefit which I believe to be wholly inexigent and create hardships to students who will be admitted but who will not be able to make good the requirement of attendance as prescribed already by the Bhiwani Education Board. The intervention sought for by the first petitioner cannot be judicially countenanced.

The writ petition is dismissed as above.
