

Raghuvinder and ors. Vs. Vinod and ors.

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of ₹2,75,000/- (₹ Two Lac Seventy Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim. As suggested by learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellants No.1 and 2, equally, by way of cheques, to be delivered to learned counsel for the appellants by learned counsel for the Insurance Company on 16.11.2015, otherwise, two months' time is allowed to the Insurance Company to deposit the amount before the MACT, failing which, interest at the rate of 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. Appellants No.1 and 2 may furnish their bank account particulars with IFS Code to the Insurance Company/MACT.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
