The petitioner claims allotment of a dwelling unit as a resident of one of the 18 colonies, the inhabitants of which are required to be rehabilitated in terms of Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme-2006 framed for rehabilitation of slum dwellers. The claim of the petitioner shall be examined in terms of Division Bench judgment of this Court in *CWP No.2317 of 2014* titled **Dinesh Kumar and others v. U.T. of Chandigarh and others**, decided on 22.12.2014, preferably within a period of 3 months.

In view thereof, the present writ petition is disposed of in terms of Dinesh Kumar's case (supra).

The petitioner may submit additional documents, if so warranted within a period of one month from today.
