By way of this application, applicant-respondent No.3 prays that main appeal i.e., FAO No. 5256 of 2010 “Mohinder Kaur & ors. Vs. Varinder Singh & Ors.” be disposed of in terms of compromise reached between the applicant and non-applicants-appellants.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Vishwajit Bedi, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of non-applicants – appellants.

Heard.

It is submitted on behalf of the applicant-respondent No.3 and is not disputed on behalf of non-applicants-appellants that the matter has been compromised between the parties and under the compromise applicant-

respondent No.3 has agreed to pay a sum of Rs.3,85,000/- over and above the compensation awarded by the learned Tribunal to the non-applicants-appellants in full and final settlement of their claim arising out of the motor vehicle accident that took place on 26.11.2006 on account of rash and negligent driving of a vehicle, bearing temporary No. MKE/T/1 – 6072 DVR, Engine No. D18010012, Chassis No. T63002183K06 by respondent Varinder Singh which claimed life of Baldev Raj. The agreed amount is undertaken to be paid within a period of three weeks from today.

As agreed, learned counsel for the applicant-respondent No.3 shall hand-over a cheque/demand draft in the sum of Rs.3.85 lacs within a period of three weeks to learned counsel for the non-applicants-appellants, failing which agreed amount of Rs.3.85 lacs shall carry interest @ 6% per annum till payment/realisation thereof.

Main appeal is disposed of accordingly.
