The same has attained finality. Therefore, the petitioner is entitled for interest on belated settlement of retiral benefits. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition.

Accordingly, he is permitted to withdraw the petition reserving liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 19.3.2014.
