AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was allotted the work of cutting 188 trees with wood of 145.50 Quebec meters. Petitioner deposited an amount of ₹ 14,51,000/- within the time stipulated. He could only take 118 Quebec meters wood from the spot out of the total wood and 27.50 Quebec meters are still left out and lying at the spot, which the petitioner wants to pick up and remove but some employees of the respondents are not permitting the same. He has been approaching the authorities by way of representations, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-5 and P-6 dated 08.11.2014 and 26.11.2014 but without any result.

Counsel contends that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to file a fresh detailed representation to the Divisional

Regional Manger, Northern Railways, Ferozepur Cantt-respondent No. 3, who may be directed to consider and pass appropriate orders in this regard.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to the Divisional Regional Manger, Northern Railways, Ferozepur Cantt-respondent No. 3 within a period of three weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the said respondent within a period of 45 days' from the date of submission of such representation, by passing a speaking order. In case the same is accepted, the appropriate orders/permission may be passed/granted to the petitioner.

Copy of the order be given dasti to the counsel for the petitioner under signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
