The petitioner was working as a Conductor with the respondent-Pepsu Road Transport, Corporation (for short PRTC) . In the year 1992 he was posted under the Depot Manager, PRTC, Barnala. Vide order dated 30.12.1992, he was placed under suspension. On 27.01.1993 he was charged sheeted. He submitted reply denying all allegations levelled against him. An Enquiry Officer was appointed by the respondents and services of the petitioner were terminated vide order dated 29.07.1993. A statutory appeal filed by the petitioner against the termination order was rejected vide order dated 29.04.1998.

The petitioner, thereafter, filed a suit for declaration against the order of his termination as well as the order dismissing

his appeal. The said suit was dismissed and the first appeal as well as Regular Second Appeal filed by the petitioner were also dismissed.

Now, the only recourse available with the petitioner is to file Special Leave Petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India against the order passed in regular second appeal.

Instead of filing SLP before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the petitioner has filed the instant writ petition seeking direction to reinstate him with all consequential benefits.

Since the remedy for seeking such direction has already been availed by him as referred to above, the instant writ petition for the same/similar relief is not maintainable.

Dismissed.
