Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the final notification dated 12.12.2014 (Annexure P-3) under Rule 9 of the Delimitation of Wards of Municipalities Rules, 1972 for delimitation of wards in the Municipal Council, Jagraon and for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the objections dated 07.11.2014 raised by the petitioner against the draft scheme issued on 29.10.2014 in view of the Delimitation of Wards of Municipalities Rules, 1972.

Admittedly, notification for holding of election has been

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issued in the State of Punjab. This Court has no doubt that once the election process has started, no interference is required to stall the election process. However, having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after perusing the paper-book, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2, to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as mentioned in representation dated 24.12.2014 (Annexure P-4), and redress the same in accordance with law at the earliest.
