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RAJESH BINDAL, J.

The present petition has been filed impugning the seniority list of Junior Engineers (Annexure P-5), which was finalized on 1.2.2010. The writ petition was filed in this Court in May, 2012, after a delay of more than two years. After notice of motion was issued, respondents were served for 18.7.2012.

On 14.11.2014, Mr. Sanchit Punia, Advocate appeared for the petitioner and sought time to address arguments. Today, learned counsel stated that he had informed the petitioner, after seeking adjournment on the last date of hearing i.e. 14.11.2014. He further submitted that Mr. S.K. Tamak, Advocate, who had filed the present petition has been appointed Additional District and Sessions Judge in Chhattisgarh. He further submitted that the petitioner did not contact him to give fresh power of attorney.

Considering the factual matrix, where counsel appearing has no power of attorney furnished by the petitioner in his favour and the counsel, who had filed the present petition has been appointed Additional District and Sessions Judge in Chhattishgarh long back, I do not find any ground to adjourn the petition any further, once despite knowledge, the petitioner is not taking care of his case, like furnishing of fresh power of attorney to the counsel, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
