This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner on the grounds that the respondent-Corporation had resorted to open selection process for the posts of Assistant; he had been placed at Sr. No.1 on the waiting list; one selected candidate did not join but instead of offering appointment to him, some body else had been appointed.

The only argument raised is that in a prior selection, one similarly situated wait-listed candidate was appointed.

In reply, the stand taken is that the person who was selected in the merit list in the case of the petitioner kept seeking extensions and during

that time various writ petitions were filed in respect of these and other selections, details of which have been given in para 5 of the reply. The respondent-University did not fill up the post during the pendency of those writ petitions and ultimately by that time those writ petitions were decided, the waiting list had come to an end.

No replication has been filed. In the circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner. Consequently, this writ petition is dismissed.
