This petition has been filed against a show cause notice and is therefore, pre-mature. The petitioner may file reply to the show cause notice and this Court has no doubt that the competent authority will give an effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and consider all the submissions made by him at the time of hearing to impress upon the competent authority that his name is not on the list of bogus candidates with experience certificates. This Court has also no doubt that the argument raised by Mr. Brar that even if one takes away the marks assigned to the experience certificate assuming that the experience certificate was bogus, even then his client would still make the grade of selection. The petitioner has been working as a teacher since 27.10.2008.

The petition is disposed of as pre-mature with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court in case any adverse order is passed against him.
