The prayer in the present writ petition is for quashing of the order dated 13.01.2014 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner was directed to deposit the amount of contributory provident fund. A writ in the nature of mandamus for providing the petitioner the retiral benefits has also been prayed for.

In the reply filed by respondents No.1 to 5 and 7, it has been averred that the petitioner has already deposited the amount of ₹ 40,543/- as contributory provident on 13.05.2014. Accordingly, the pension and gratuity of late Satbir Singh, the husband of the petitioner has been revised by counting the service rendered by him in privately government aided school w.e.f. 07.05.1965 to 17.12.1978. The pension has been revised to ₹ 5906/- per month and other admissible allowances. The residual balance of gratuity of ₹ 86873/- has been paid to her on

01.10.2015 and same has been transferred to her bank account.

Receipt has also been attached on 01.10.2015 (Annexure R-1/3).

In such circumstances, it is apparent that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly.
