On 22.12.2014, this Court had passed the following
order:-

“The Court is not entirely convinced with the bona fides of the petitioner. However, since he states that his seniority is prejudiced due to the false certificate of the date of death of birth of respondent No.4, the Court would like him to deposit a sum of Rs.50,000/- in order to establish his bona fides. If his allegations are found to be incorrect, the amount shall stand forfeited.

Issue notice of motion for 3.5.2015 subject to the deposit of aforesaid amount with the Registrar of this Court within a period of three weeks from today.”

Office report indicates that the petitioner has not

deposited an amount of ₹ 50,000/-, in terms of the order referred

to above. None is present on behalf of the petitioner to pursue the matter either.

That being so, the petition is dismissed for want of prosecution.
