This revision petition was admitted on 5.12.2006.

Since respondent could not be served for want of correct address, vide order dated 16.5.2014, the petitioner was asked to furnish correct address of the respondent and he was directed to be served for 8.9.2014. On 8.9.2014, again counsel for the petitioner sought time and undertook to furnish correct address of the respondent within a week and the matter was adjourned to 27.2.2015. By that date also, since compliance of order dated 27.2.2015 was not made, request of the petitioner to comply with the order dated 27.2.2015 was accepted, but with a rider that if 'compliance is not made, legal consequence of dismissal of revision petition would follow'.
