The petitioners seek an order directing the respondent – bank to issue a no objection certificate and to return the title deeds. The petitioners state that the matter had been settled between the parties as recorded in the order of the Debts Recovery Tribunal dated 10.09.2013 (Annexure P9). That order records the settlement and even directs the title deeds to be returned after compliance of the compromise. The petitioners state that they have already paid all the amounts under the compromise.

2. The petitioners are always at liberty to seek the same orders in enforcement of the order of the Debts Recovery Tribunal. There is no warrant for passing the orders in the writ jurisdiction to enforce the order of the Debts Recovery Tribunal.

3. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with liberty as aforesaid.
