LISA GILL, J.

It is contended that despite petitioner having retired on 30.09.2014, retiral dues are not being released to her. There is no impediment for release of the same but no action is being taken by the respondents despite specific directions issued by this Court vide judgment dated 01.10.2012 in LPA No. 920 of 2012 and connected appeals. Respondent No. 5 was appellant in LPA No. 1184 of 2012. It is submitted that petitioner has approached the authorities time and again for release of her retiral dues but no action is being taken. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for a direction to take necessary action in a time bound manner.

In view of facts as above, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to competent authority to consider this writ petition as

a representation on behalf of the petitioner and decide the matter expeditiously by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of four months from receipt of certified copy of this order alongwith a copy of the writ petition. Benefits, if any, found due to the petitioner shall be released expeditiously preferably within a period of six weeks thereafter.
