DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (Oral)

Through the present petition, the petitioner who is serving the respondents as a Mathematics Master has challenged his transfer which has been ordered vide the impugned order dated 24.11.2015 (Annexure P-8).

A perusal of the impugned order shows that the transfer of the petitioner has been made on administrative grounds. No mala fide has been even alleged. The only ground raised and pressed before me is that the impugned order of transfer has been passed without giving details of the administrative grounds on which the petitioner has been transferred.

The aforesaid argument raised is liable to be considered only to be rejected.

No detailed reasons are required to be given for transferring an employee on administrative grounds which is an exigency of service,

especially when, as noticed above, no extreme hardship, malafide or violation of any statutory rule is shown.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the present petition and consequently, order dismissal of the same.
