LISA GILL, J.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage direction be issued to respondent No. 3 to take a conscious decision on his application dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) for grant of extension of service for one year in terms of notification dated 27.02.2013 (Annexure P-1). It is submitted that there is no impediment for grant of extension of service as prayed for but the respondents are not taking any action on his request.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed at the time of arguments, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3 to expeditiously decide application dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of one month from receipt of certified copy of this order.
