Learned counsel for the petitioners referred to Notification No. 32/2/2011-41B1 dated 11.3.2015 issued by the State Government in exercise of power conferred by sub section (1) of Section 93 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (in short "the Act") whereby land of the petitioners is withdrawn from acquisition in respect of which award dated 4.12.2014 (Annexure P-2) was passed.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners states

that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh writ petition challenging notification dated 11.3.2015 issued by respondent No. 1 under Section 93(1) of the Act.
