Allowed, as prayed for. Annexure R-2 is taken on record.

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Instant writ petition has been filed by the Punjab Agricultural University Pensioners Welfare Association (Regd.) through its President Sukhdev Singh.

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By way of this writ petition, the petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-University to regularly pay the pension to the members of the Association in the first week of every month in view of order dated 30.07.2008 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Writ Petition (C) No.35 of 2006 wherein it has been observed that every incumbent is entitled to pension from the bank in the first week of every month.

Learned counsel for the respondent-University states that arrears have been paid to the members of the association-petitioner and ensures that in future members of the association-petitioner will be paid pension by 7th to 10th of every month.

In view of above, I direct that University would pay the pension by 10th of every month failing which the respondent-University would pay interest @ 10% per annum.

So far as the relief of arrears of revised pension is concerned, the petitioner-association wants to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to its members/employees of the University on whose behalf the claim has been made in the writ petition, to file individual writ petitions. Allowed to do so.

Disposed of in the aforementioned terms.

The members of the association-petitioner will be at liberty to file fresh petitions individually as aforestated and may also include any other claim if so advised. However, before filing the writ petitions, the

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members of association will be at liberty to move appropriate representations to the university as well as govt. for consideration of their claim upon which appropriate orders shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners.
