Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to conduct the election of Managing Committee of Anand Bhawan Club of National Fertilizer Limited, Nangal Unit, Nangal, District Ropar as the same has been kept in abeyance since 2005.

This Court has doubt that such a petition is maintainable. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have submitted a representation dated 29.08.2015 (Annexure P/3) to the Chief Manager (P&A) NFL, Naya Nangal Unit. Learned counsel prays

that direction may be issued to the respondents authorities to consider

representation (Annexure P/3) within a stipulated period.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and after perusing the paper-book, instant writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to look into the grievance of the petitioners specifically made in representation dated 29.08.2015 (Annexure P/3) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and copy of the order so passed shall be communicated to the petitioners.
