MAHESH GROVER.J.

The petitioner, who is working on contractual basis, apprehends termination which is not fortified by any material on record. There is nothing to suggest that the respondents are going to terminate the services of the petitioner by replacing him with another set of regular or contractual employee. Consequently, the apprehension of the petitioner is found to be unfounded.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is working since 2009, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case the petitioner makes a grievance by filing a representation to the respondents within a period of four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of two months thereafter.
