Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly submits that in view of the fact that the judgments cited by learned counsel for the petitioners, Annexure P-8, P-9 and P-10, have become final, against the respondents, this petition can be allowed in terms of the said judgments.

This petition is, consequently, disposed of in terms of the judgment of a Coordinate Bench, dated 16.09.2010, passed in CWP-8285-2004, affirmed by a Division Bench vide order dated 03.02.2011, passed in LPA-207-2011. Both the aforesaid judgments have been annexed as Annexure P-8 and P-9 respectively, with this petition.

The petitioners would make the deposit in terms of the aforesaid judgments within three months, after which the respondent-Corporation would release the benefits to them within a further period of two months, thereafter.
