HEMANT GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

The grievance of the petitioners is that the award in respect of compensation was announced by the Land Acquisition Collector on 26.11.2014 on the basis of average market value of three years. It is contended that such process of determination of the compensation is contrary to the provisions of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (hereinafter mentioned as 'the Act').

Learned counsel for the petitioners fairly admits that there is statutory remedy against the amount of compensation awarded by the Land Acquisition Collector as contemplated under Section 64 of the Act.

In view of the said fact, we deem it appropriate to allow the present writ petition to be withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to seek appropriate remedy under law.

It shall be open to the petitioners to raise all questions of law and fact before the appropriate authority for determination of the proper market value.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
