1. The prayer made in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents; not to make any recovery of interest in pursuance to the orders (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.2 in view of the pendency of appeal before the JETC(Appeals) and not to attach the bank account of the petitioner for recovery of interest in pursuance to the attachment letter dated 28.10.2015 (Annexure P-19) issued to HDFC Bank.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for stay before the First Appellate Authority at the first instance.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
