The petitioner is a handicapped person being visually impaired and seeks the help of a scribe/writer for the examination which is to be conducted on tomorrow i.e. 12.11.2015 at 10.30 A.M onwards (two examinations) at Government Model High School, Sector 20-D, Chandigarh. His request for arranging a scribe has been declined by respondent No.2-Commission vide communication dated 05.12.2015 (Annexure P-10), which is subject matter of challenge.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Punjab has taken instructions from the under Secretary of the Commission, Ms. Kusum Bector and has assured this Court that the scribe shall be made available to the petitioner at the abovesaid Examination Centre well in advance at 9.00 A.M. This will enable the petitioner a opportunity to interact with the said scribe before the commencement of the examination.

In view of the said assurance given by the State counsel, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly by accepting the said undertaking.
