Mr. Amar Vivek, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 2 to 4 – District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, Tehsildar, Ambala and the Deputy Commissioner of Police (Urban), Ambala states that upon application being made action will be taken as per the order dated 08.01.2014 at Annexure P7. This of course would be subject to there being any stay order from any Court or Tribunal.

2. Mr. Rajiv Atma Ram, learned senior counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent Nos. 5 to 8 has raised several disputes regarding the correctness of the amount claimed. It is not necessary for us to entertain these disputes for two reasons. Firstly, this is not a petition brought by the respondent Nos. 5 to 8. Secondly, the nature of the disputes is such that they ought to be agitated in appropriate proceedings under the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002.

3. The petition is accordingly disposed of.
