DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The prayer made in the present petition is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix the pay of the petitioner by granting him benefit of stepping-up of pay at par with his junior of reserved category along with all consequential benefits in view of the Division bench judgment of this Court in **Charan Dass Vs. State of Haryana** decided on 18.11.2008 as well as instructions dated 5.3.2009 and 29.5.2009.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a bunch of writ petitions were pending before this Court and all petitions were disposed of vide order dated 19.8.2013 whereby directions were issued to the

respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner on the basis of judgment rendered in **Ajit Singh Janjuna and others Vs. State of Punjab and others** JT 1999 (7) SC 153. The present case is also at par with said case but it could not be disposed of on that day.

Learned counsel for the respondents has not disputed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of order passed in **Charan Dass's case (supra)**, the present petition is disposed of in the same terms.
