1. The representation given by the petitioner to respondent Nos.2 and 4 under Annexure P-5 shall be disposed of and I direct that the respondents shall issue to the petitioner a fresh registration number and registration certificate. The counsel for the petitioner states that he is not asking for the VIP number which he had bid at the auction previously in terms of the decision of State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission. The said statement is recorded.
