The petitioners seek the relief of exercising the new option in view of the changed circumstances in the Master Scale, in terms of the orders passed in CWP-7464-2009 titled *Surinder Kumar & others Vs. State of Punjab & others*, decided on 25.02.2010 (Annexure P4). The consequential benefits along with arrears are, accordingly, demanded.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that legal notice dated 03.07.2015 (Annexure P11) has been served upon the respondents asking for the necessary relief and he would be satisfied if a time bound direction is issued for decision of his grouse.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Sidhu accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and has been supplied a copy of the paperbook.

In view of the limited relief sought, this Court does not feel it necessary to ask the respondents to file response.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 03.07.2015 (Annexure P11) within 2 months from today. If the petitioners are found entitled to the said benefits, same be disbursed to them, one month, thereafter. In case the benefits are to be denied, reasoned order be passed and same be communicated to the petitioners.

With the abovesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
