LISA GILL, J.

It is submitted that similarly situated persons as the petitioners had approached this Court for the same relief as claimed by the present petitioner. Writ petitions filed by said petitioners stand decided, directing the Appellate Authority to decide their appeal in a time bound manner. Recovery from the said petitioners was also stayed till the decision by the Appellate Authority on their prayer for interim relief. Learned counsel refers to various orders attached with this writ petition as Annexures P-12 to P-19.

Limited prayer addressed at this stage is that appeal filed by the petitioner be decided in a time bound manner and till his prayer for interim relief is not decided, no recovery be effected from him.

In view of the peculiar circumstances of this case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 – Appellate Authority to dispose of the appeal filed by the petitioner expeditiously, preferably within a period of six months from receipt of certified copy of this order. Appellate authority shall also consider the prayer for interim relief addressed by the petitioner. Till the decision on the said prayer, no recovery be effected from the petitioner.
