By way of instant writ petition, under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks quashing of impugned order dated 10.07.2008 (Annexure P-10), passed by respondent No.2 and direction to grant interest @ 18% per annum on the amount of pensionary and retiral benefits.

The petitioner had earlier approached by filing CWP No. 3827 of 2004, which was dismissed, vide order dated 29.04.2014 (Annexure P-4). Against the said order, the petitioner preferred Letters Patent Appeal No. 1175 of 2014, which was also dismissed, by virtue of order dated 24.07.2014 (Annexure P-5). The petitioner has now laid claim for release of his retiral benefits. The learned counsel contends that for the redressal of his grievance, the petitioner has served legal notice dated 03.06.2014 (Annexure P-12), however, the same has not been decided so far.

Keeping in view the prayer made in the petition, without

adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, which is stated to be respondent No. 3, to treat the present petition as representation and passed the appropriate order, preferably within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
