The petitioner prays for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to refund security of Rs.14,85,460/-.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of orders passed by this Court, the petitioner has surrendered all three liquor vends and has not filed any application for renewal. The respondents are, therefore, required to refund the security deposited by the petitioner but they have not taken any steps to refund the security.

We have heard counsel for the petitioner, perused the paper book and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the controversy, dispose of the writ petition by directing the respondents(s) concerned to consider and dispose of the petitioner's representation/application (Annexure P-2), for refund, within two months from receipt of a certified copy of this order.
