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SURYA KANT, J (ORAL)

The petitioner seeks directions for allotment of booth-cum-alternative site at par with other shopkeepers of Dashmesh Market, Phase XI, SAS Nagar Mohali.

2. Petitioner's case is that he is running his shop in Dashmesh Market (Rehri Market), Phase XI, Mohali and is in business of Juice and Vegetables since 1991. His entire family is stated to be dependent upon the petitioner. His grievance is that while other similarly placed shopkeepers have been rehabilitated,

the authorities have singled out him.

3. The Estate Officer of Greater Mohali Area Development Authority has filed reply by way of an affidavit in which after a brief reference to the rehabilitation steps taken by the authorities, it is pointed out that based upon the report of Deputy Commissioner, SAS Nagar Mohali to the effect that red card No. 1907 was issued in the name of petitioner's father late Atma Singh who was a riot victim, the petitioner has been asked vide letters dated 14.06.2011, 13.09.2011 and 21.10.2011 to submit the details of all the legal heirs of his deceased father and submit their 'No Objection Certificates', so that the family, as one unit, can be allotted booth site.

4. In view of the fact that the authorities are inclined to allot a booth to the petitioner subject to the completion of requisite conditions, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction that no sooner the petitioner would furnish 'No Objection Certificates' from other legal heirs of his deceased father, the allotment of booth site shall be made within a period of three months.
