This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to the respondent department to release the monthly compassionate allowance to the petitioner as per the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the dependents of deceased government employees rules, 2006 with immediate effect.

Learned State counsel informs that entire benefits stands released in favour of the petitioner.
