The petitioner seeks the admission in BDS 1st year course on account of the availability of vacant seats, as has been noticed by this Court in CWP-21411-2015 titled *Sukhmeen Madaan Vs. The Panjab University, Chandigarh & others*, decided on 17.11.2015. In the alternative, the relief sought is for issuance of migration certificate from the Bhojiya Dental College & Hospital, Bhudbaddi, District Solan, against the vacant seats.

Regarding the first relief, this Court is of the opinion that since the cut off date of 30.09.2015 has long gone by and the petitioner has not approached this Court within reasonable time, as had been done in the case of Sukhmeen Madaan (supra), no benefit can be granted for admission on the same parity.

Regarding the second relief of migration, which the petitioner now claims, nothing could be shown from the paperbook that the petitioner has made any such request to the competent authorities and that there has been denial of the same. In such

circumstances, in the absence of the authorities having been approached, it is settled principle that no writ of mandamus can be issued.

Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition and submits that he may be given liberty to approach the authorities for the relief of migration.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to approach the authorities for the relief of migration, against the vacant seats.
