PARAMJEET SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* to quash the award dated 11.06.2015 (Annexure P-10) passed by respondent No.1 – Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Sirsa (hereinafter referred to as 'PLAPUS'), whereby application filed by respondent No.2 under Section 22-C of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 has been partly allowed and petitioner has been directed to refund the amount of ₹ 41,000/- to respondent No.2 within a period of 30 days from the date of the award, failing which respondent No.2 was held entitled to recover the same with interest @ 9% per annum.

I need not reproduce the facts of the case as the issue involved

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in this case has been dealt with by this Court in CWP No.7031 of 2014 titled '*The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd. and another v. Gurdarshan Singh and another*' decided on 19.09.2015.

The decision rendered in the case of *The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd.* (supra) is fully applicable to the present writ petition and as such liable to be dismissed.

Resultantly, this writ petition is dismissed.
